

The Georgia Student Health Survey (GSHS) is an anonymous, statewide survey instrument created by the Georgia Department of Education and administered online each year to students in grades 3-12. Survey results assist in the identification of safety, climate, and health issues that impact student achievement and help guide school prevention and intervention strategies. The following data was extracted from the Georgia Student Health Survey. The total number of participants for each school year were 459 for 2020-2021, 1,113 for 2021-2022, 1,124 for 2022-2023.
